

MEMBERSHIP TERMS & CONDITIONS

Membership

1. Members are bound and subject to the Club Membership Terms & Conditions, and in addition the LTA rules and the LTA Disciplinary Code. Members contravening the terms and conditions of each of the above may be suspended and membership revoked.
2. Players use the club courts and facilities at their own risk.
3. Members are required to provide 'next of kin' details on the Club Spark platform.
4. The club has 100% court access from 1st April to mid-October. From then until 31st March it has shared use but play is still available most days and weekends, but members may have to put a net out and remove it after play. See website for details.
5. Guests must be accompanied by a member - the member is responsible for paying the guest fee (£5) into the Club's bank account with the reference 'Guest fees'. Guests can only play up to 3 times in a season before needing to become a full paying member.
6. Juniors including the Parent/ Practice membership must give preference to other members after 6pm or whenever there is an organised club activity.
7. Only full paying members may have private coaching sessions on the courts.
8. Junior members under 16 years must be accompanied by an onsite parent/guardian.
9. There may be photography taken at events to be used to promote the club, if anyone does not wish to be photographed they must make a committee member aware.
10. Members are encouraged to become LTA Advantage members. This is currently free and can be done at: <https://www.lta.org.uk/advantage/>
11. Only members who are registered as LTA Advantage members and opt-in to the LTA ballot process will be eligible for entry into the LTA Wimbledon ticket ballot.

Court/ Club House Use

12. For the security and safety of members the gate access code for the courts **must not** be disclosed, and care should be taken that the gate code is not overseen. Any member found to have told a non-member the padlock code will be suspended.
13. Access to the courts should be via the gate nearest the road.
14. Nets must be fastened up when members leave a court and no one is waiting to play.
15. Floodlights must be turned off and the padlock locked, before leaving the courts empty.
16. Please take home rubbish, including ball tube lids, or use the bin by the lower gate.
17. Check that you have all your belongings before leaving the courts.
18. Club House - after use any cups must be washed and rubbish removed when leaving.
19. Members must lock the gates to the courts when leaving them empty.
20. Players must wear clean non-marking tennis shoes, no ridged-soles or heels.
21. Play must be limited to one set when other members are waiting to play.
22. Singles (other than tournament games) may only be played when no-one is waiting.
23. The scheduling of Club Tournament matches should ideally avoid club social sessions.
24. Tennis balls will only be provided by the club for the group coaching sessions, scheduled social tennis sessions and league practice nights; at all other times members must provide their own tennis balls.
